

PRIVACY POLICY

Privacy statement

Majster-Pol Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością Sp. k. with a registered office in Mienia 291, 05-319 Cegłów, entered in the Register of Businesses conducted by the District Court for the city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIV Commercial Division of the National Court Register as KRS number 0000695647 (hereinafter referred to as "Majster-Pol") understands the importance of safety of Users' personal data obtained during the use of our website. We treat the protection of Users' personal data very seriously. Therefore we would like to explain which data are stored. This privacy statement provides information about security measures taken by us.

Collection and processing of personal data

Providing personal information is not obligatory in order to use our websites, except where it may be necessary to deliver a desired product or implement a requested service. Unless stated otherwise in the following chapters, the legal basis for handling Users' personal information stems from the fact that such action is necessary to allow proper functionality of the website.

Personal data is collected only if User provides them during registering, filling in the forms, sending electronic mail, placing orders for products or services, sending inquiries about the ordered materials and in other similar situations in which User chooses to provide such information to Majster-Pol.

The database and its contents remain in Majster-Pol. User's personal information will not be transferred by us or our agents to be used in any form to third parties, unless User gives his/her consent, or where it will be required by applicable law.

Cookies

This website uses the so called „cookies”. Cookies are small text files stored in the memory of Your device via a browser. They store some information (such as preferred language or page setup), which Your web browser may (depending on the time of storing the cookie) upload again the next time You visit our site.

Our website uses the following cookies:

- Session cookies - in order to maintain the user's session, check the log-in status and activity between subpages, recognise a new and a returning User, adjust the website template to a given type of Internet browser and screen width. They are temporary files which are stored in the User's browser until the browser is closed.
- Persistent cookies - files used by the site statistics and in order to preserve the User's preferences. The files are stored in the User's browser for a specified number of days or until they are manually removed from the Internet browser by the User.
- Third party cookies - used in Google Maps and Google Analytics, social plug-ins, presented instructional videos.

By accessing our website, Your browser will transfer some data to our web server. It is done for technical reasons and it is necessary to provide the required information. In order to facilitate the access to the website, the following data is collected, used and stored for a short time:

1. IP address
2. the date and time of access
3. the difference between the time zone to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT)
4. viewed content (specific page)
5. the status of the access code/HTTP
6. transferred volume of data
7. the party requesting access
8. the browser, language settings, version of operating system and of the browser

Moreover, in order to protect our legitimate interests, we store the data for a limited period of time. This enables us to keep track of personal data in the case of attempting or performing an unauthorized access to our servers.

Most browsers are configured in such a way that the automatic acceptance of cookies is possible. However, cookies can be disabled or a browser can be set in such a way to notify User about cookies prior to acceptance. The lack of acceptance of cookies may result in an inability to use certain features of our website. The following websites contain information on how to change the settings in Your browser:
