INTENDED USE

A broad-spectrum biocide. The product is a liquid (an aqueous solution) used for conservation and protection of the stonework, masonry elements or construction materials other than wood; it is intended for protection against harmful effects of the mold (category II, group 10). It is particularly suitable for controlling microorganisms found on thin-layer plaster containing a high percentage of organic compounds, as well as on traditional plasters.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Do not dilute the product prior to use. Wash the affected surface using a water jet to remove loosely bound impurities and microorganisms. When dry, apply the product with a brush, paint brush or sponge to the affected surface until it is completely wetted, and leave for at least 6-12 hours. Thoroughly remove mechanically remaining impurities (e.g. using water under high pressure or vapour stream). If necessary, after the surface dries up completely, it is recommended to use the product again. The final effect is visible after approx. 1-3 days. Further works (e.g. painting) may start only after the surface is completely dried and after last application of the biocide. Consumption: ca. 0,15 l.m² for a single application on walls, depending on the contamination, surface absorptivity and structure.

COMPOSITION

Water, Alkyl (C12-16) dimethylbenzyl ammonium chloride (0,48g/100g) and 2-octyl-2H-isothiazol-3-one (0,049g/100g), additives.

STORAGE

Store in an undamaged packaging, in a dry place at temperatures between +5°C and +25°C. Shelf life is 12 months from the manufacture date found on the packaging.

Prevent from entering sewage system, other wastewater or open tanks. Packaging can be re-used after cleaning.

General advice: Move the victim from an exposure area, keep calm. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If symptoms persist or you feel unwell, consult a doctor.

Inhalation: Move the victim to fresh air, keep warm and calm. If symptoms persist or you feel unwell, consult a doctor.

Contact with skin: Take off contaminated clothing and shoes immediately. Wash contaminated skin thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. If irritation appears, consult a physician.

Contact with eyes: Remove contact lenses. Flush eyes with plenty of water for 10 minutes holding the eyelids open. If irritation appears, consult a physician.

Ingestion: Rinse mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting – risk of aspiration, product can enter the lungs. If a victim is conscious, give 1-2 glasses of water to drink. Get medical attention immediately.
